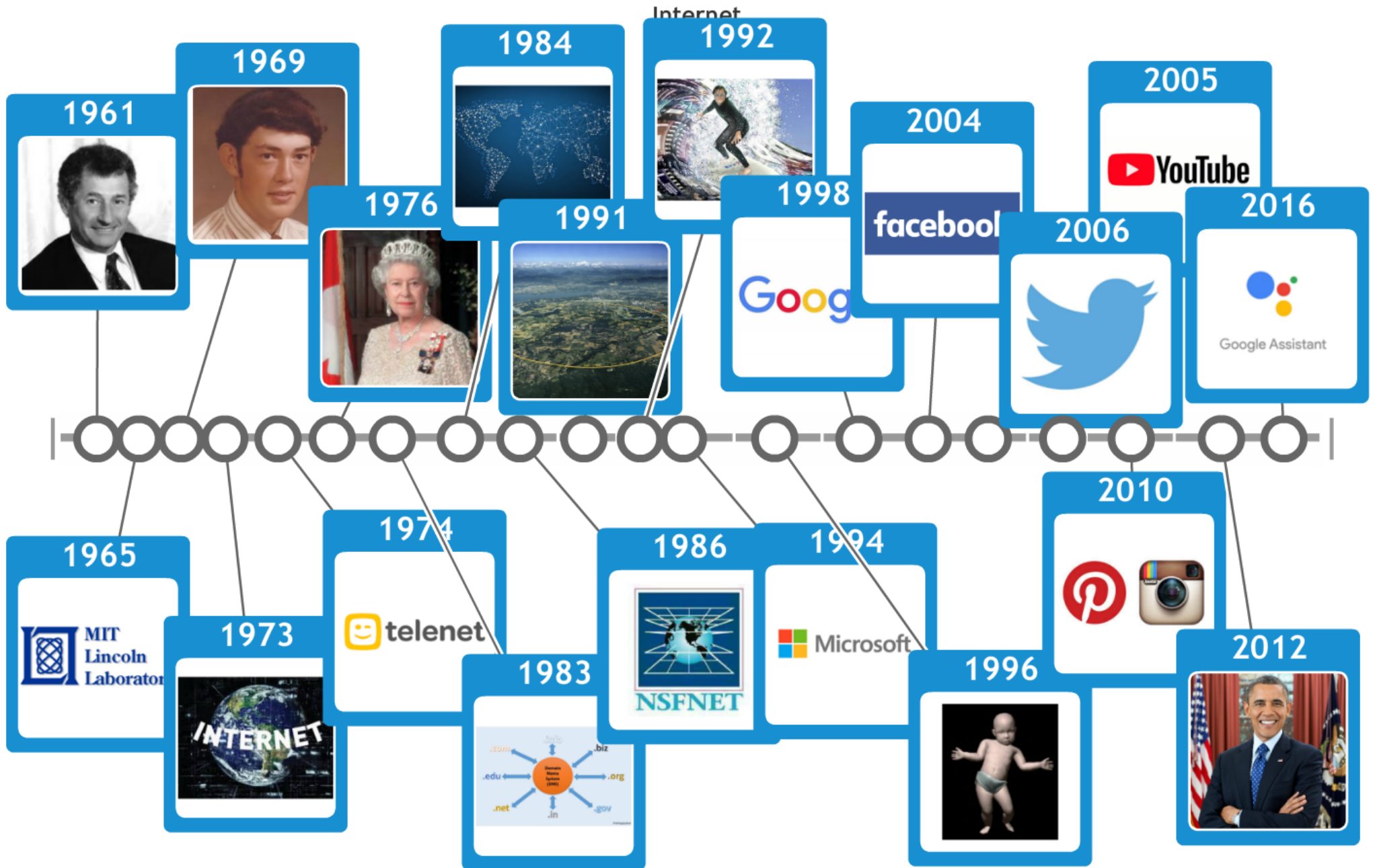

## Internet

- **1961**  
Leonard Kleinrock wrote about ARPANET, the predecessor of internet, in a paper entitled "Information flow in large communication nets".
- **1965**  
Two computers at MIT Lincoln Lab communicate with one another using packet-switch tech.
- **1969**  
The first message is "LO" which was an attempt by student Charles Klein to login to SRI computer from the university.
- **1973**  
The term Internet is born.
- **1974**  
The first Internet service provider is born, known as TELENET.
- **1976**  
Queen Elizabeth II hits the send button on her first e-mail.
- **1983**  
The Domain Name System establishes the familiar .com, .org, .net.
- **1984**  
William Gibson is the first to use the term Cyberspace.
- **1986**  
The NSFNET was essentially a network of networks that connected academic users along with the ARPANET
- **1991**  
CERN introduces the world wide web to the public
- **1992**  
The first audio and video are distributed over the internet. The phrase surfing the net is popularized
- **1994**  
Netscape Communications is born. Microsoft creates a web browser for windows 95
- **1996**  
A 3D animation dubbed "The dancing baby" becomes one of the first viral videos.
- **1998**  
Google is born
- **2004**  
Facebook is born.
- **2005**  
Youtube.com launches.
- **2006**  
Twitter launches.
- **2010**  
The social media sites Pinterest and Instagram are launched.
- **2012**  
President Obama's administration announces its opposition to major parts of the Stop Piracy Act and the Protect Intellectual Property Act.
- **2016**  
GOOGLE unveils Google Assistant, the voice-activated personal assistant program.
